RECREATION IN BEAUMONT

Our Community Recreation Center (CRC), located at 1310 Oak Valley Parkway, is home to a variety of services including various sports programs, fitness classes, and the Senior Center. The Parks & Recreation Department also manages over two dozen parks throughout the city.

The Beaumont-Cherry Valley Recreation and Parks District offers additional athletic programs and manages Noble Creek Park, home to Beaumont Youth Baseball and a variety of adult softball leagues.

TRANSPORTATION

Beaumont Transit operates a variety of fixed and commuter routes connecting residents throughout the Pass Area, the Inland Empire and beyond. BUILDING PERMITS

Below are frequent home improvements that require a permit:

- Addition of air conditioners
- Structures over 120 square feet
- Pool and spas over 24" in depth
- Adding/changing/removing electrical circuits or outlets
- Replacing hot water heaters
- Enclosing of a garage, carport, porch or covered patio
- Changing/replacing/adding gas, water, vent, waste, or soil pipe
- Masonry walls over 3ft in height

YARD SALES

Residents are allowed two yard sales per year. Permits are required and cost \$5.00 each.
