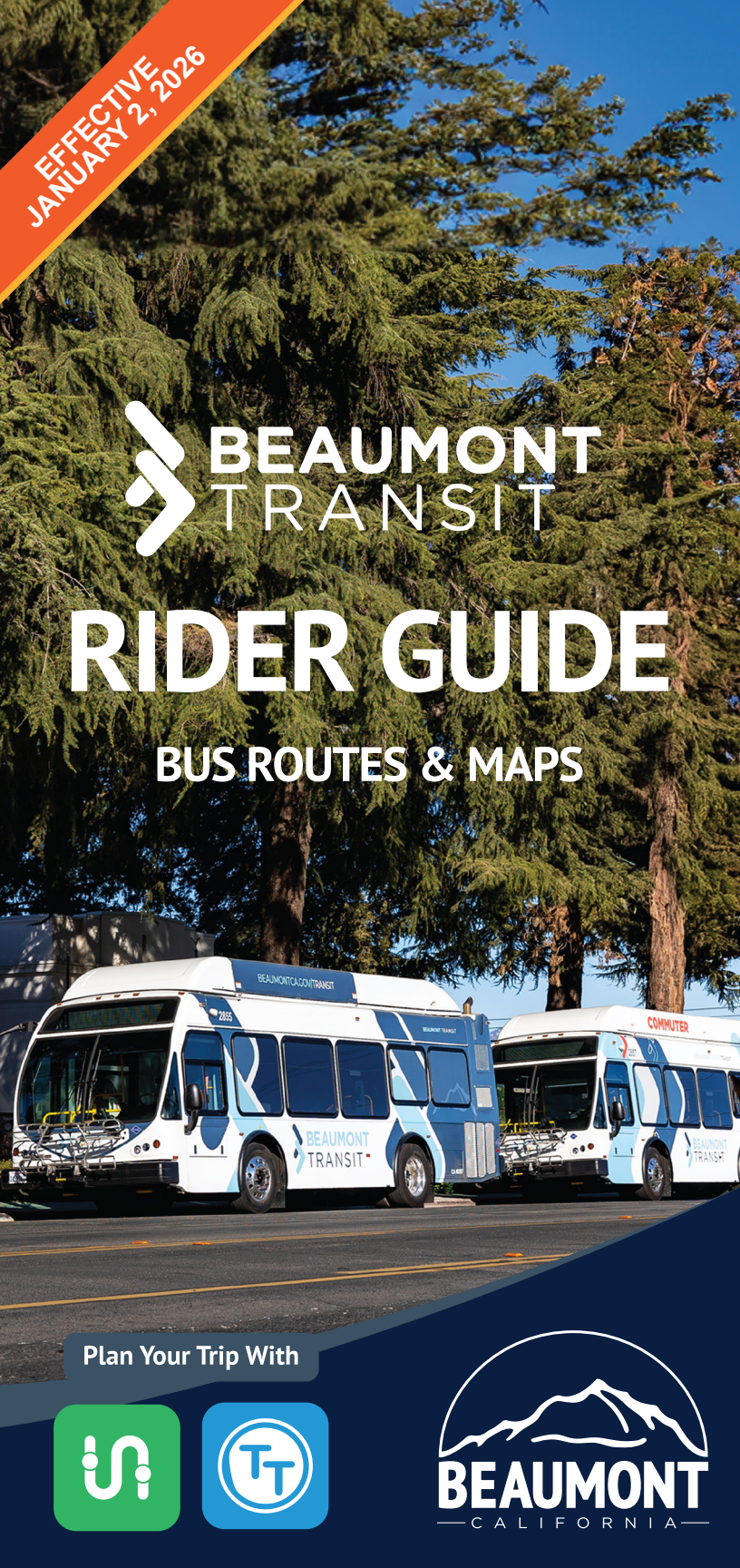

TRANSFERS

Beaumont Transit does not issue internal transfers to its passengers. If you need to change buses to complete your trip, you will have to pay another fare to board the next bus, unless you purchase a day pass or monthly pass.



Beaumont Transit will accept Banning Connect transfer tickets at the following two locations only: Walmart or San Geronio Hospital. Transfer tickets are free and are valid for one hour after they were issued.

Banning Connect will accept Beaumont Transit transfer tickets at points of connection. Transfer tickets are free and are valid for one hour after they were issued.



You may use your Riverside Transit Agency (RTA) multi-day pass for a free transfer at points of connection on local fixed-routes only. RTA multi-day passes are valid for a \$1.00 discount on Commuter Link routes.

RTA will accept Beaumont Transit day passes or monthly passes as a free transfer at points of connection. Not valid on Commuter Link routes or Dial-A-Ride.

VICTOR VALLEY TRANSIT

You may use your VVTA multi-day pass for a \$1.00 discount at points of connection.



You may use your Omnitrans multi-day pass for a \$1.00 discount at points of connection.

Omnitrans will accept Beaumont Transit day passes or monthly passes as a free transfer at points of connection.



HOW TO RIDE

1 Catching the Bus

- ✓ Stand where the driver can see you.
- ✓ Check the route and wave to signal the driver.

2 Boarding the Bus

- ✓ Wait for the bus to fully stop.
- ✓ Have your fare ready.
- ✓ Find a seat or use handrails.

RIDING TIPS & SAFETY

Never chase or board a moving bus.

Stay alert for oncoming buses and traffic.

As a courtesy, please give priority seating to seniors or persons disabilities.

Follow the driver's instructions and remain behind the safety line while the bus is in motion.

Keep aisles, doors, and exits clear at all times.

Be ready to exit and move promptly when your stop arrives.

Step away from the bus after exiting.

Inform the driver if you have a bike to add or remove from the bike rack.



SERVICE ANIMAL AND PET POLICY

Service Animals

Service animals trained to assist a person with a disability are always welcome.

Pets

Pets must remain in a secure, commercially made carrier on your lap.

The carrier must prevent bedding or waste from escaping.

Pets must not interfere with service animals or other passengers.

Pets should not block aisles, doorways, or seats.

Both service animals and pets must always be under control of the owner or handler.



BICYCLE POLICY

Bicycles are allowed on a first-come, first-served basis if they fit on the bike rack.

Foldable, non-motorized bikes (max. 28"x 20"x 11") are permitted under the seat.

Electric bikes with sealed gel, lithium ion, or NiCad batteries are allowed.

Electric bikes with liquid lead acid batteries and gas-powered bikes are not permitted.

Beaumont Transit is not responsible for lost or damaged bicycles.

BEHAVIOR & SAFETY

We reserve the right to refuse service to persons who are intoxicated, abusive, or present a health and/or safety hazard to other passengers or the driver. **Any action that interferes with the safe operation of the bus or that compromises the safety of the driver or any of the passengers is not permitted.**



IMPORTANT RULES

- No unsealed food or beverages allowed on the bus.
- Limit of 2 carry-on packages per passenger.
- Strollers and carts must be folded before boarding.
- No smoking or vaping allowed on the bus.
- No loud music allowed on the bus.
- No abusive or threatening behavior toward drivers or passengers.

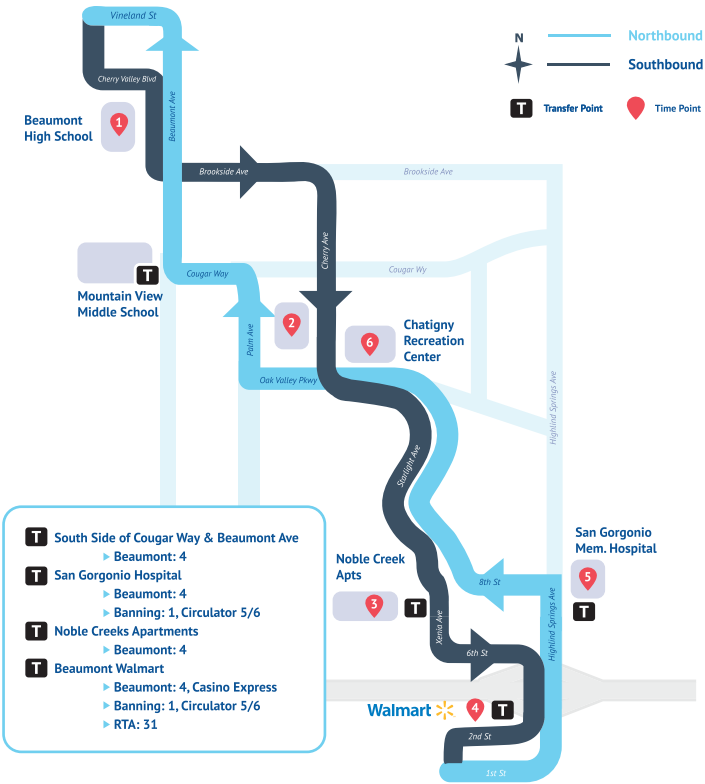

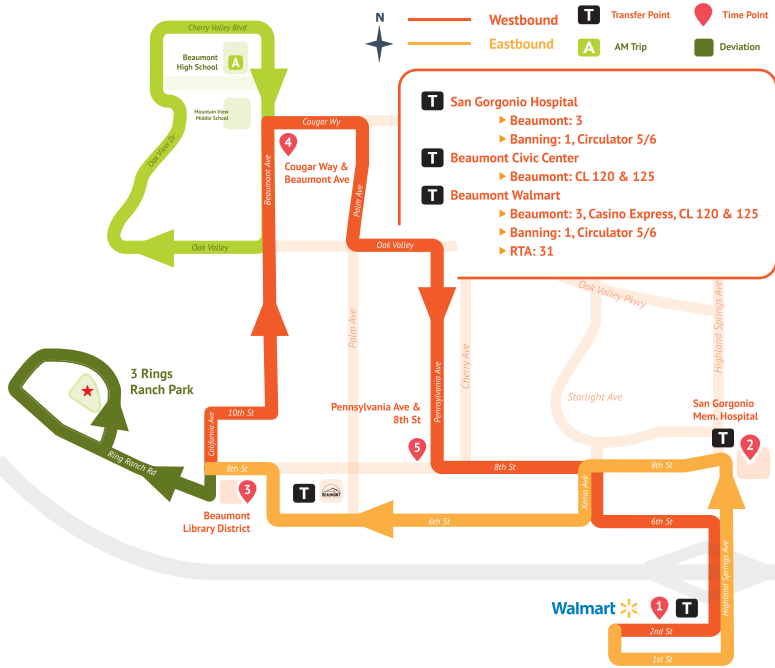

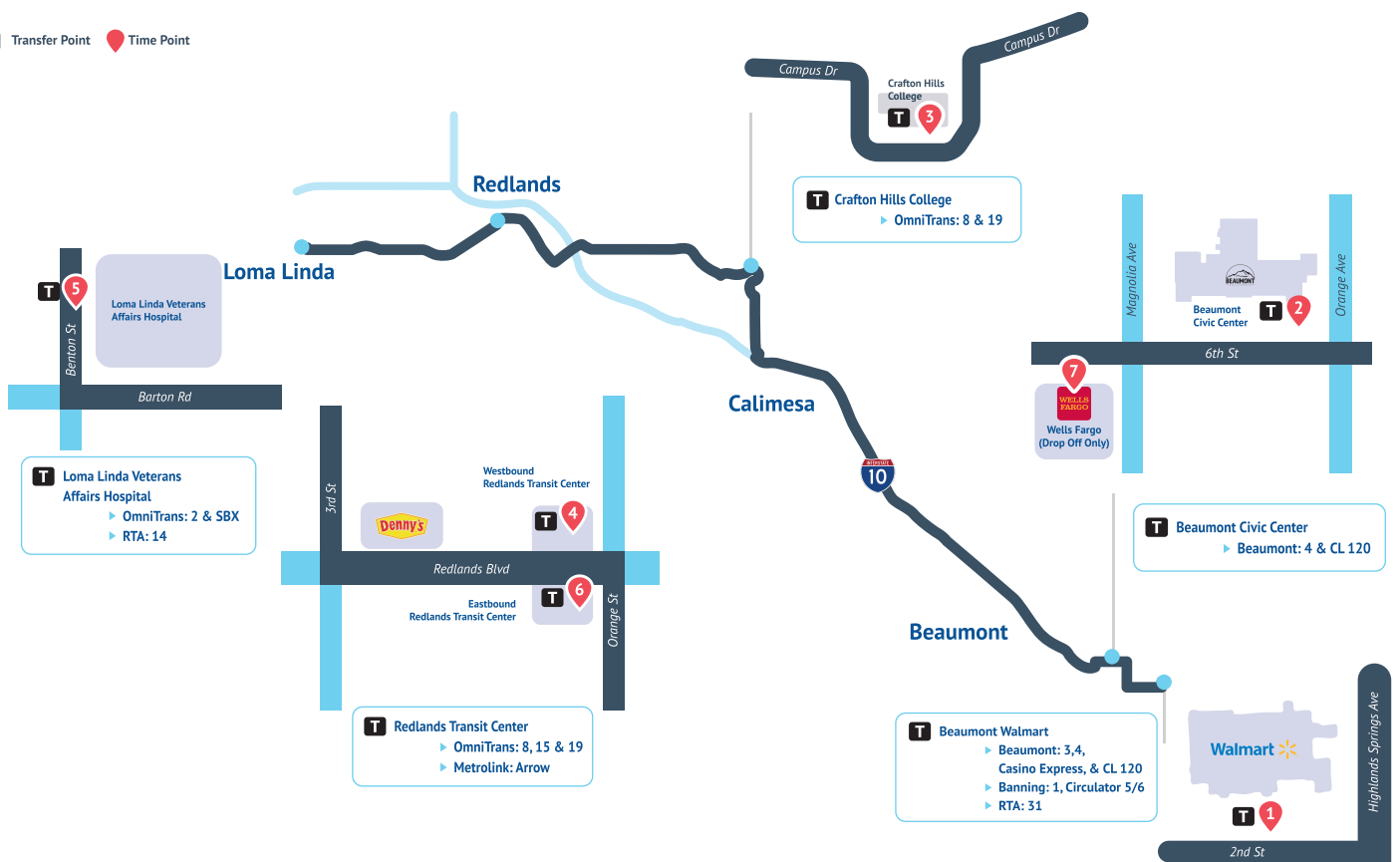

Dial-A-Ride is a door-to-door, advanced reservation transportation service for persons certified under the American with Disabilities Act (ADA).

ADA CERTIFICATION

Certification is done through the Riverside Transit Agency (RTA). Apply online at [riversidetransit.com](https://www.riversidetransit.com) or call (951)565-5002.

RESERVATIONS

Reservations are on a first-come first-served basis. Passengers are asked to call (951) 769-8530 at least 24 hours in advanced to make a reservation.

When making a reservation, please have the following information available:

- > First and last name
- > Desired pick-up time(s)
- > Travel date
- > Pick-up and destination address

SERVICE ANIMALS

Service animals necessary for travel by riders with disabilities are allowed on all Beaumont Transit vehicles.

NO-SHOW POLICY

Same day cancellations are considered a no-show. If 3 no-shows accumulate in a 60 day period, a 10 day suspension will result.

If a trip needs to be cancelled please call (951)769-8530 as early as possible.

***If you plan to use a PCA (Personal Care Attendant) at no charge, qualified passenger must have it noted on their ADA card and present it each time the bus is boarded.
